

Job Title: Glazier Installer

## **Position Summary:**

The Glazier is responsible for the installation, repair, and replacement of glass and aluminum systems in commercial and residential settings. This includes storefronts, curtain walls, doors, windows, mirrors, and glass partitions. The role requires precision, attention to safety.

## **Key Responsibilities:**

- Install and secure glass or aluminum panels using appropriate hardware, sealants, and techniques
- Measure, cut, and fit glass or aluminum components to precise specifications
- Handle, transport, and position large sheets of glass using suction cups or manual methods
- Apply weather sealants, gaskets, setting blocks, and spacers to ensure proper insulation and watertight installations
- Remove old or broken glass and repair or replace damaged framing or supports
- Maintain tools and equipment in good working condition and keep a clean, organized work area
- Follow all company and OSHA safety protocols, including proper PPE usage and fall protection
- Work cooperatively with site supervisors, general contractors, and other trades to complete jobs on schedule
- Assist with loading, unloading, and staging of materials at job sites or shop



## Skills:

- Proficiency using hand tools, power tools, and glazing equipment (drills, screw guns, lifts, etc.)
- Physical stamina and strength to lift and maneuver heavy glass and materials (up to 100 lbs)
- Comfortable working at heights and on ladders, scaffolds, or lifts
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation to jobsites

## **Working Conditions:**

- Primarily outdoor or semi-enclosed construction environments
- Exposure to weather elements, dust, and noise
- Frequently required to stand, climb, kneel, and bend
- May require early morning starts, travel, and extended hours depending on project demands
